  - Misson have finalised their draft plan and are currently seeking quotes for printing of the final document.
  - Beckingham are at the Action Planning stage. They have got their survey results back and will be arranging an Action Planning event for September.
  - Laneham are currently bidding for funding to cover the printing of their Plan. The Plan was not initially produced with NRCC support, but they are now involved in supporting the remainder of the process.
  - An Expression of Interest regarding the production of a Parish Plan has been received from Sutton cum Lound.

### Community Safety (Safer Communities)

The Bassetlaw Community Safety Partnership has now merged with Newark and Sherwood's. The merger is for a pilot period, which will be formalised 1 April 2008.

The partnership is striving to reduce crime by 22.5% by April 2008 from 2003-2004. It is also addressing priorities defined in the strategy for the period 2005-2008.

The Drug and Alcohol Action team is working closely with both the LSP and the community safety partnership to tackle the drug and alcohol agenda. There is a drive to establish closer link with communities to focus on these issue specifically. In tandem, this is establishing a countywide strategic approach to addressing the alcohol agenda.

The CSP through SSCF funding 2007-2008 have agreed to fund the following projects:

- ▶ YISP (Youth Inclusion Support Programme) – To deliver the Prevent and Deter strand of the Prolific and Other Priority Offenders Scheme.
- ▶ Alcohol Project – To provide Tier 2 Alcohol Posts to deliver specialist alcohol workers in a direct access setting. These posts would deliver assessment and referral as well as providing treatment intervention. Priorities addressed will be to reduce alcohol fuelled violent crime and criminal damage.

- ▶ Prolific & Other Priority Offenders Scheme – To continue the work commenced by the Sherwood Project, which has previously been supported by the Partnership. To deliver the Catch/Convict/Resettle strand of the Prolific and Other Priority Offenders Scheme and to reduce acquisitive crime and the subsequent harm to victims.
- ▶ Police Safe Scheme – To provide target hardening and protection of the properties of vulnerable people. To reduce the rate of repeat victimisation and the rate of burglary across the partnership area.
- ▶ Bassetlaw Domestic Violence Forum, Sanctuary Scheme – To provide a Sanctuary scheme for Bassetlaw and enable survivors of domestic violence and their children to stay in their own home where they choose to do so. To reduce the rate of violent crime across the partnership area and protect victims of domestic violence.
- ▶ Star System – To provide CCTV and where necessary, audio facilities to Black and Minority Ethnic Premises which have been affected by criminal activity. The Star System helps to detect racist and criminal activities and to assist in detection and prosecution.
- ▶ Making All Children Safe – This is an interagency approach aimed at educating Y6 students about the dangers with the community. This project aims to reduce the level of avoidable injury and deliberate fire in our community.

- ▶ Harworth week of action - w/c 11 June  
Multi-agency approach, trying to make Harworth a safer place and reduce the amount of fire calls.

12 month 4 moduled youth intervention programme, multi-agency approach

SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD GROUPS

In the Bassetlaw area the Community Safety Partnership has created a number of Safer Neighbourhood Groups, which will work at addressing concerns affecting their communities. Safer Neighbourhood Groups include community representatives such as local councillors, and residents, business people, and Beat Officers and Police Community Support Officers.

OPERATION ENDETULOUS

This operation was set up to tackle auto-crime and volume crime in and around Worksop. The operation was successful in providing intelligence.

The Action Plan for 2007/08 is currently being agreed. The priorities of the Partnership are as follows:

Priority 1:	To reduce levels of Anti Social Behaviour across the Partnership area
Priority 2:	To reduce the rate of burglary across the Partnership area
Priority 3:	To reduce the rate of violent crime across the Partnership area
Priority 4:	To reduce the rate of vehicle crime across the Partnership area
Priority 5:	To reduce levels of arson across the Partnership area
Priority 6:	To reduce and prevent avoidable injuries on the road and within the home
Priority 7:	To reduce the use of drugs and alcohol and protect local communities from anti social behaviour and crime resulting from drug and alcohol use
Cross-cutting Objective:	To improve the effectiveness of the Community Safety Partnership

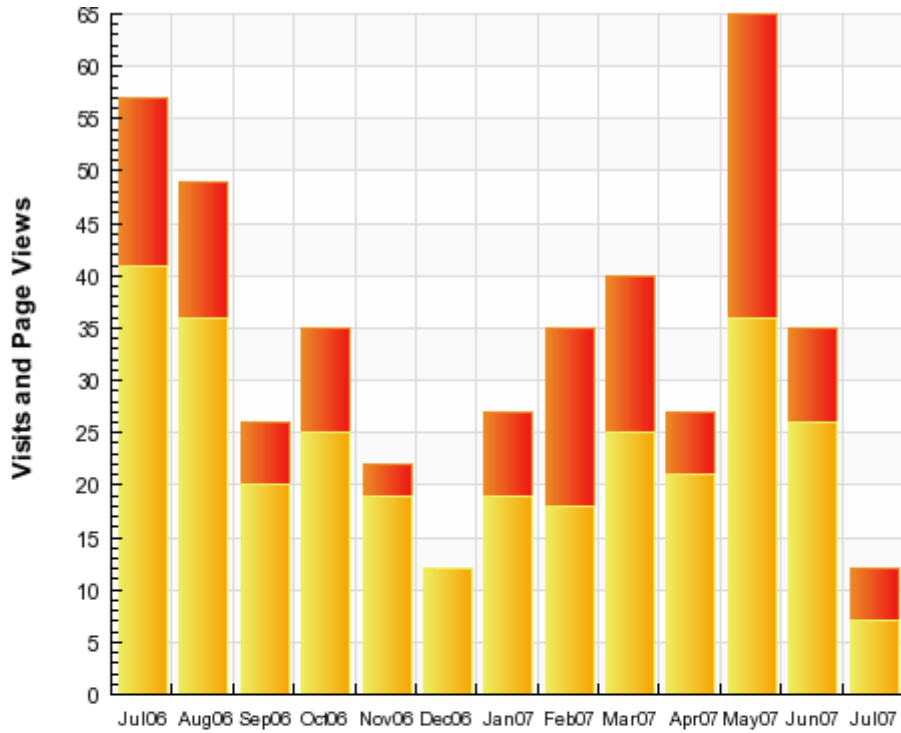
